

Cascade Clamps

Cascade Clamp - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store hiring only four individuals. Total sales for that particular year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and other parts. During 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is one of the leading international producers within the material handling business.

Manufacture and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business opportunities. During the past sixty years, the material handling trade has developed into a very complex field and Cascade has proudly played a part in this development. Cascade at present continues to develop as the leader provider of forklift accessories and numerous associated products. The business feels certain in their ability to be able to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was made in the year 1956, to be able to house all plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present head office. Following fifteen years of business, total staff reached a hundred and eighty workers and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

The next manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Santa Clarita. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry when the business recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in the year 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing services within the continental USA to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Santa Clarita. Cascade products are made worldwide due to many subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is designed to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 after buying 5 corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international best in blades.
