Doosan Forklift Part - Doosan Infracore Company Ltd. is a transnational organization consisting of Diesel Engines, Defense Industry products, Industrial Vehicles, Construction Technologies and Machine Tools and Mechanization Systems.

In the United States, Doosan Infracore America Corporation is headquartered in Suwanee, Georgia. It is home to a 170,000 square foot manufacturing facility, which is the home of the Compact Equipment and Construction department. West Caldwell, New Jersey is home to the Machine Tool division and Cleveland, Santa Clarita is home to the Lift truck division. The U.S. headquarters in Georgia facilitates a first rate parts operation capable of supplying an excess of 25,000 line items to support Lift Truck, Compact Equipment, Machine Tool and Construction client needs.

With a system consisting of over 90 independent sellers, the forklift group supplies quality materials handling equipment to the wideranging North American market. Doosan Infracore America Lift Truck dealers successfully operate in over 220 service and product sales locations throughout Canada and the U.S. The forklift product line remarkably comprises of 63 different models consisting of 82 various battery and engine configurations of Electric-powered and Internal Combustion vehicles. Capacities of these various vehicle versions range from 3,000 to 33,000 lbs. All vehicles are designed in an ISO 9001 qualified facility.

Doosan Infracore America is the fastest expanding lift truck company in the North American marketplace, due to their reliability in maintaining a high degree of consumer service quality and optimum product performance to all Doosan Infracore Lift Truck users. The U.S. lift Truck division situated in Cleveland has a expert team knowledgeable in Sales, Purchasing, Advertising, Logistical and Technical Support.

At first the home-based forklift market in Korea was an open import enterprise. Korea Machinery Co. Ltd. began in 1960, to import fully assembled lift trucks as part of a domestic machinery expansion venture. Product sales of these products were originally targeted to state-run firms, large scale corporations, and the armed forces. This eventually led to a unification with Daewoo Heavy Industries Ltd. In 1976, the Forklift Division commenced business operations throughout Korea to service and sell this heavy equipment. By 1978, a lift truck manufacturing plant was successfully completed. Continuous technical education became the new focus for enhancing quality and product development.

Daewoo started the first domestic lift truck business in 1967, and quickly gained a whopping 90% share in the Korean Materials Handling market. By the 1980's, Daewoo's sophisticated technological advancements combined with sales success placed them in a position of substantial expansion of their lift truck business.

In 1981, Caterpillar Industrial Inc. of the United States, proposed a cooperative venture project to counter act competitive pressures in the US materials handling industry. This plan greatly expanded Daewoo's forklift sales. Construction was completed in 1984 to facilitate a contemporary plant which helped launch the company for the fabrication of high added-value products suitable for export. In 1993, the company had a global sales system and started exporting versions they had established through in-house technology, as an independent product. Certifications were then acquired from CE of Europe, UL of the United States and ISO 14001 and ISO 9001, securing growth possibilities into overseas marketplaces.
